Hurst Green to 2030 and the Hurst Green Neighbourhood Plan is the community initiative that seeks to have a genuine influence on the positive transformation of our community, including Silver Hill, Swiftsden and the surrounding area.

Using feedback from resident surveys and from public engagement events held throughout 2018 and 2019, the aims and objectives for the neighbourhood plan were developed. A further public consultation ran during the Autumn of 2019, which saw every household in the parish receive a printed copy of these and a consultation form.

During the pandemic Councillors and volunteers have continued gathering evidence and ideas, and have published progress on the hurstgreen2030.uk website and in theHurst. Now the restrictions have been lifted, we invite you to explore these themes, potential policies and development schemes in a 1 day exhibition on the 30th of October.

Drop in and view the exhibition, and if you wish, speak to your local Councillors, volunteers, and professional planners - most importantly have your say ahead of a formal consultation later in the year.
